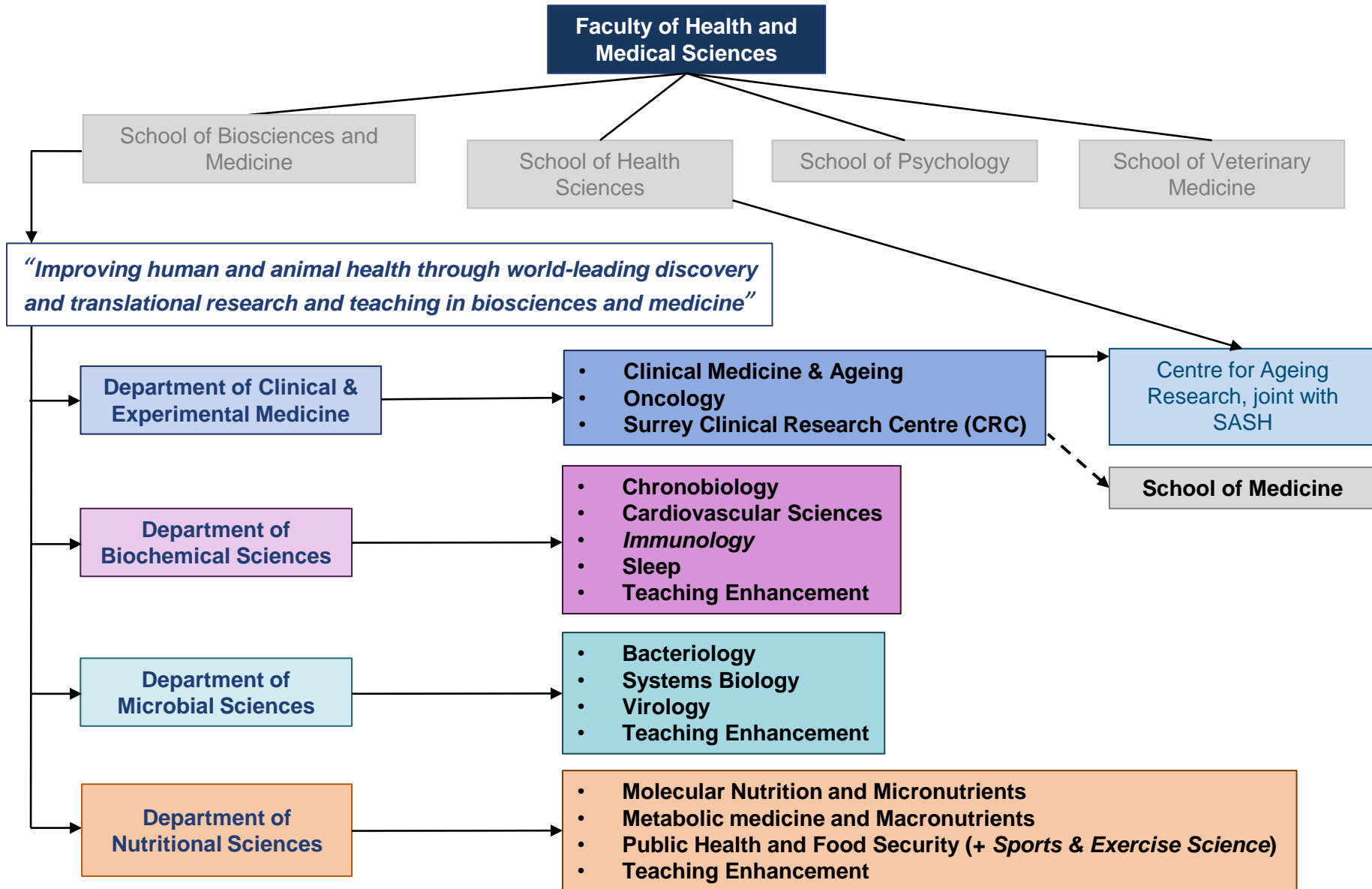


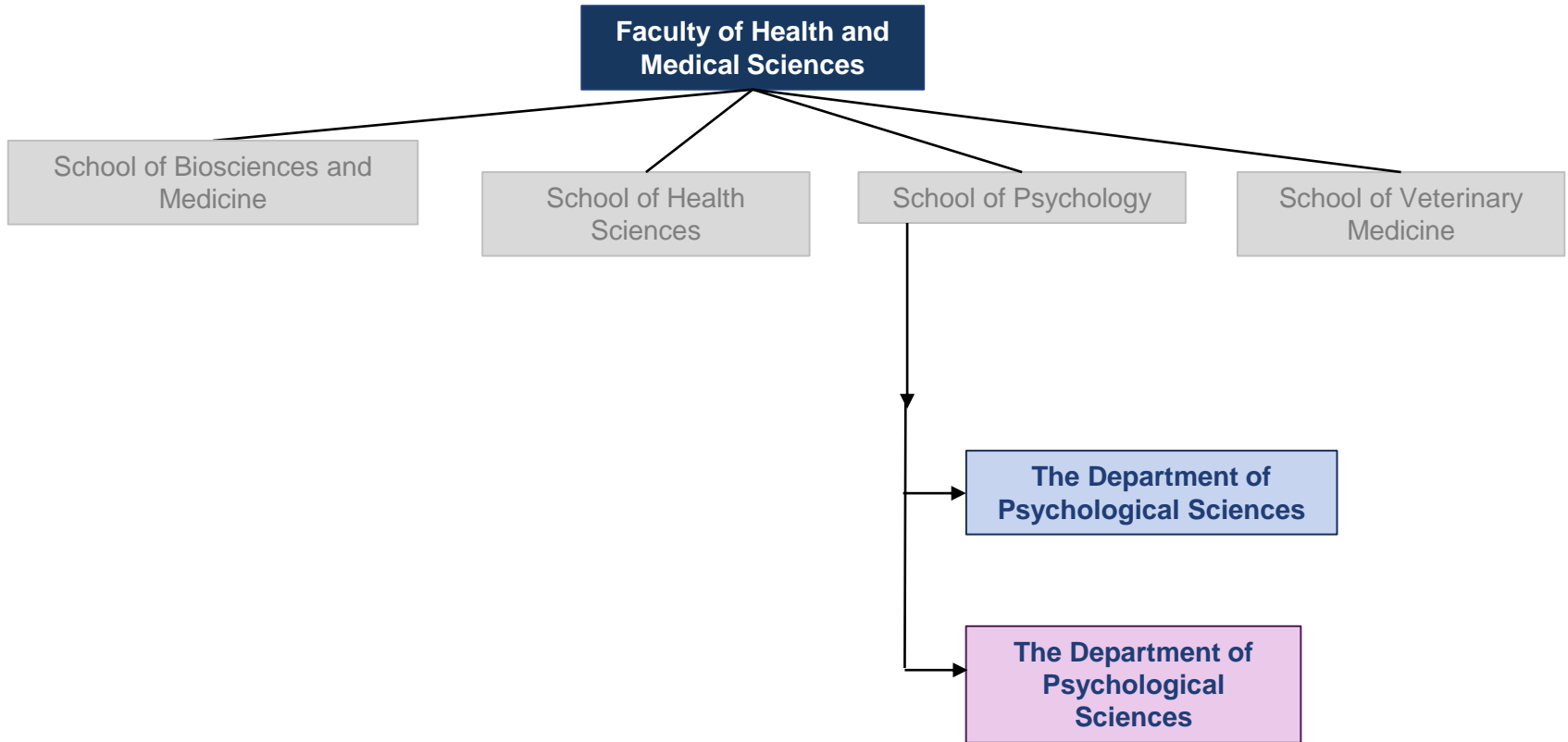

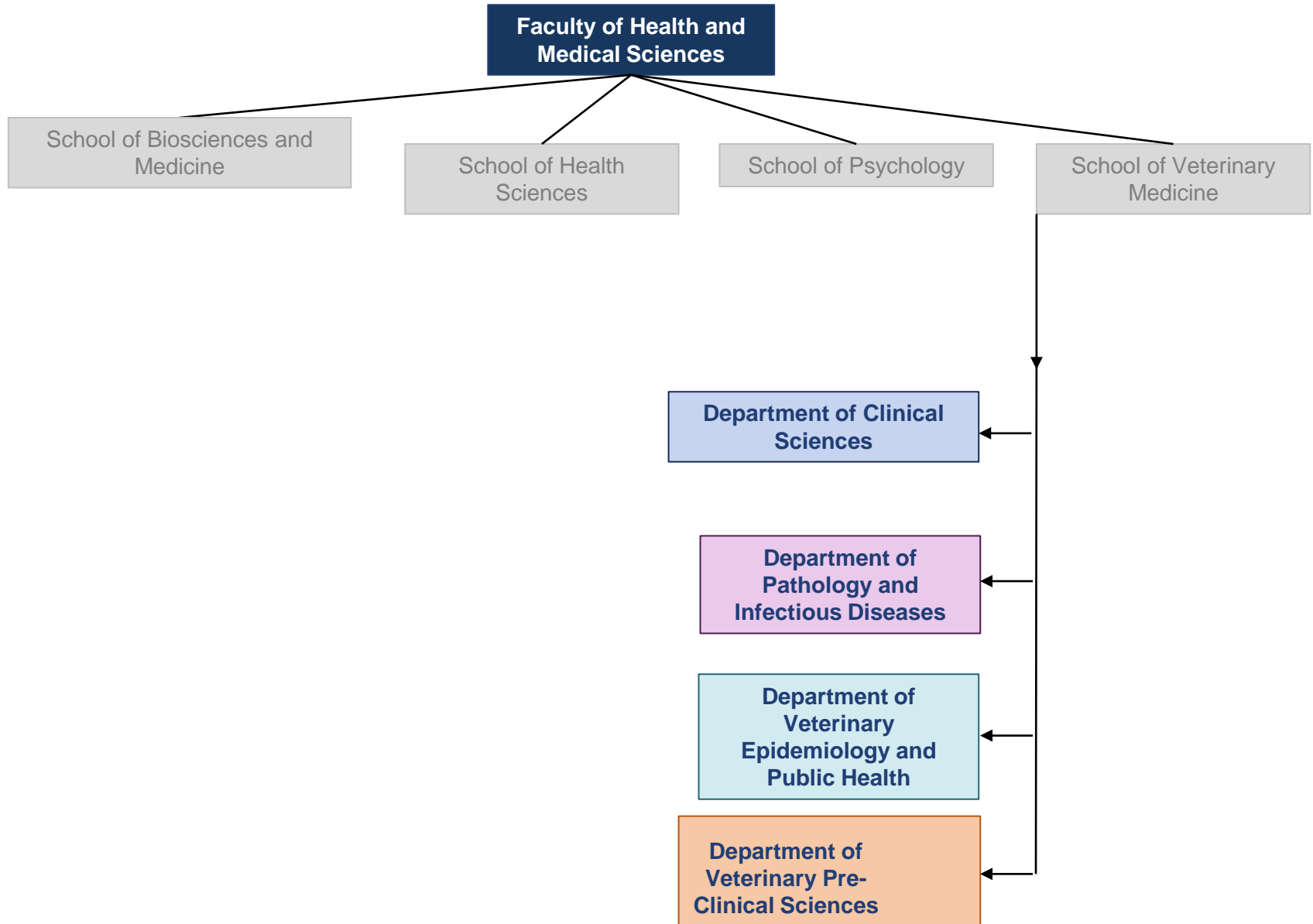

PhD Scholarship Opportunities 2019

- If you wish to apply to study for a PhD in the Faculty of Health and Medical Sciences at Surrey to start in October 2019 you will be eligible to apply for a fee scholarship.
